## ITINERARY: SOUTH AND NORTH ANDAMAN

This itinerary will focus on The Andaman Sea's best spots to see Whale Sharks such as Koh Bon and Koh Tachai in the Similan National park or Hin Daeng-Hin Muang in Koh Lanta National Park but we will also visit other amazing dive sites in the South and North Andaman Sea such as Richelieu Rock.

Not only will you have some fantastic dives but this cruise is also your chance to try Black Water diving!

The itinerary is not fixed, we will remain flexible as much as we can in case we hear of a Whale Shark or Manta sighting nearby (except for Similan islands which requires booking ahead).

We plan 4 dives per day (including 1 sunset or night dive), 4 meals and a presentation per day.

Kirsty, our special guest on this trip is a Marine biologist and ocean conservationist, she will be happy to answer all the questions you may have about whale Sharks and the many other species she is passionate about...
